CHICO - Starting in late May, the Center for Economic Development, California State University, Chico Research Foundation, will conduct a telephone survey to households and businesses in Butte, Lassen, Modoc, Plumas, Shasta, Siskiyou, and Tehama counties.

The survey will be utilized to identify areas throughout the region that are served, underserved or unserved by high speed Internet service.

Economic development and education administrators, internet service providers, local government leaders and other business professionals will be able to utilize the information to make decisions about the services they provide to those in the Northeastern region of California. High speed Internet is a critical component of economic, education and business development.

This project is funded by the California Emerging Technology Fund, which was established and funded by the SBC-AT&T and Verizon-MCI merger agreements approved by the California Public Utilities Commission in November 2005.

The fund focuses on "achieving ever-present access to broadband and advanced services in California, particularly in underserved communities through the use of existing and emerging technologies." The McConnell Foundation also provided substantial funding for the project.

CED has contracted with the Program for Applied Research and Evaluation at the CSU Chico Research Foundation to conduct the telephone survey. All individual answers will be kept confidential.
